JACOBUS¹ DE LOCKE) was born July 29, 1861 in Graafschap, Fillmore, Michigan, and died April 20, 1938 in Holland, Michigan, married (1) HENRIETTA(HATTIE) KNOOIHUIZEN. He married (2) HENRIETTA JOHANNA ELENBAAS July 18, 1883 in Allegan County, Michigan. She was born 1861, and died 1911.

Notes for JACOB LOKKER: From the "Lokker Rutgers Chronicle" -No Date -- TWO HOLLAND MEN START BUSINESS . 1892, 100 years ago, when two of Holland's residents started a retail business. Notier and Ver Schure were operating a small business at 41 East 8th Street. This business was purchased by Mr. J Lokker and Mr. J Rutgers and, thus, the firm of Lokker Rutgers was started. Among the things sold were men's and boy's clothing, bicycles, bicycle parts, blankets, and many other items. In these early years, Mr. Lokker and Mr. Rutgers maintained an unshakable confidence in Holland and its future.

"From a modest beginning, LokkerRutgers grew with Holland and it was not long before their facilities became too small. In 1892, another of Holland's fine old stores, DuMez Bros., which was then located next door to Lokker-Rutgers, felt the need for expansion. Lokker-Rutgers purchased the DuMez building and all of the store equipment for the exorbitant sum of \$2,000. With twice the business continued to grow. Early in the 1900's, Mr. Rutgers sold his part of the business to Mr. Lokker."

OBITUARY -- Jacob Lokker, 77, one of Holland's oldest and most prominent merchants, died early this morning at his home 12th Street, after an illness of two months. He had been in a critical condition for several days due to heart trouble and complications. Mr. Lokker was connected with the LokkerRutgers Clothing Co. for 46 years. Mr. Lokker was born in a log house at Graafschap 1861, to Cornelius and Maria Nayer Lokker, immigrants from The Netherlands. Until he was 17 years old, Mr. Lokker lived and attended school located one-half mile east of his log home. On leaving the farm, Mr. Lokker went to Passiac, N.J. where he was employed for three years. He then came to Holland and until he was 22 years old, he was employed in the clothing and garment business. E. J. Harrington, located on Eighth Street, just east of College Avenue. After leaving Mr. Harrington's employ, Mr. Lokker a Christian L., organized and built the Holland Crystal Creamery at Sixth Street and Columbia Ave., which they operated for 1892, Mr. Lokker formed a partnership with the late John Rutgers and they purchased the Notier and Ver Shure Men's Clothing store, 39 East Eighth Street, the present location. Funeral services will be held Friday at 1 p.m. from the home and at 1:30 p.m. at Hope Reformed Church. The Rev. H. J. Veltman of Grand Rapids and the Rev. Paul E. Hinkamp of Hope College will officiate at the Pilgrim Home Cemetery. Pall bearers will be John Sturing, Ed Barkel, John Kobes, and Gelmer Boven, all employees of Rutgers Clothing Co., and Jake Zoerman and Peter Boven.

"For approximately 40 years, Mr. Lokker attended First Reformed Church, but about ten years ago he changed his membership to the Christian Reformed Church. He was a member of the Hosanna Dutch chorus which practices in the Sixteenth Street Christian Reformed Church. Mr. Lokker married twice. He first married Henrietta Elenbaas who died several years later. To this union were born two daughters. His second marriage was to Henrietta Knooihuizen. Surviving are the widow; two daughters, Mrs. Herbert Menery of Nashville, Mrs. J. Vande Bunte of Lansing; three grand children; and one great grand child. For 23 years, Mr. Lokker served as a member of the volunteer fire department and for 15 years he was alderman of the first ward. While a member of the common council, he was on the committee on streets and the committee on poor welfare. He also served as deputy game warden of Ottawa County, Michigan during the time that B. D. Keppel, Frank Van Ry, and H. Dykhuis were sheriffs of the county."

1900 US CENSUS --According to 1900 U.S. Census records, Jacob (born in July 1861), lived on East 9th Street in Holland with his wife Hattie (born in September 1862), and their daughters Maria (born in May 1884) and Mildred (born in April 1896). Both Jacob and Hattie were married for 17 years and Hattie was the mother of three children, two of whom were living. Both Jacob and Hattie were born in Michigan to parents who were born in the Netherlands. Jacob's occupation was listed as merchant. Both Jacob and Hattie could read, write, and speak English. They owned their home, which was mortgaged at the time.
